RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Open to all breeds of horses of all ages regardless of show history. This contest will consist of one go-round: Herd Work, Rein Work, Steer Stopping and Cow Work-Thursdays. Then final 7 ride Friday night for the championship.
2. This contest will have only one division: Open
3. Entry fees, stall fees and other charges will be established annually and will be outlined on the entry form.
4. All payments made are final. No refunds can be made if a horse is scratched for any reason.
5. Late entries will be accepted with a late entry penalty as outlined in the entry form until the day the show begins.
6. Horses will be shown in the same bridle throughout all go-rounds.
7. A split rein may be used. The traditional Romal may be used. No fingers between reins when using a romal. Roping reins are optional in the Steer Stopping. Reins may be changed for the different go-rounds.
8. No broken mouthpieces are allowed, and bits cannot have a check over 8-1/2 inches long.
9. There will be a barrier in the Steer Stopping. The penalty for breaking the barrier shall be two (2) points.
10. In the Steer Stopping portion of this contest, the horse will be judged on the rate and speed to the steer, and the ability of the horse to rate and stop the steer. The roper on the horse being judged may throw as many loops as necessary within a 90 second time limit. If more than 1 loop is thrown, the rider must recoil and build additional loops as required. If the rider fails to catch within the 90 second time limit, he/she will retire from the arena with a -0- score.
11. Bits will be checked after each go-round. A score of zero will be given for a pink or bloody mouth on the horse.
12. A rider may show only two horses.
13. NRCHA Rules and Regulations will apply in all other instances.
14. There will be no ties

APPOINTMENTS AND EQUIPMENT

Horses shall be shown astride with a stock saddle. Riders must wear a western hat or helmet approved for riding by an equine organization, long sleeve shirt and chaps. Carrying of a rope or Riata is the option of the rider.

No tie-downs are allowed. No wire, chain or other metal or rawhide device may be used in conjunction with the bit or a part of the leather chinstrap. Leather chinstrap must be flat and at least 1/2 inch wide.

If at any time during a performance in either the reining portion or the cow work portion, should a piece of equipment break, the rider shall have three (3) minutes in which to correct the broken equipment. The rider may be assisted and may replace the broken equipment with the same or equal equipment from outside the arena. Neither the horse nor the rider is allowed to leave the arena. In case of broken equipment while working the herd, the Rider may continue, provided the broken equipment does not pose a hazard to the rider or is not cruel to the horse. If the rider is unable to continue because of broken equipment, the rider will be excused with no score.
